Applicants are expected to attend a minimum of two Board meetings subsequent to applying and prior to their application being voted on. The Board meets the fourth Thursday of each month in the evening.

Board members' responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Upholding the objectives and purposes as well as the mission of the School as delineated in the By-Laws.
- Attending and actively engaging in all Board of Trustees' meetings, with no more than two successive meetings or three meetings total missed, due to personal circumstances, during a twelve-month period.
- Attending the Board orientation meeting and annual Board Retreat.
- Holding all Closed and Executive Session discussions and other sensitive Board matters as confidential.
- Attending special events and major fundraising events such as the Annual Auction.
- In addition, Board members who are not members of the faculty or administration are expected to maintain 100% participation in major school fundraising initiatives, including contributions to the Annual Giving campaign, capital campaigns and the Auction, and to actively seek contributions to Sacramento Waldorf School from others.
- Each Board member is expected to serve on one or more committees. Meetings are usually in the evenings. Committees include Buildings and Grounds, Enrollment, Finance, Development, Trustee, Strategic Plan, Marketing and Tuition Assistance.
