



Dear Sacramento Waldorf School Community,

At noon today, Governor Newsom held a press conference on school reopening. The governor was clear that any county on the "monitor list" will open the school year remotely and will only be allowed to resume in-person learning when the county has been cleared from the list for 14 days.

It is at this moment that we feel immeasurably grateful for our expansive campus and the flexibility it offers us to resume in-person instruction as soon as Sacramento County is cleared. We will use every beautiful inch of our campus to provide safe outdoor learning spaces for the students under our care.

Two weeks before school opening, on August 18, we will know Sacramento County's status and will be prepared to offer the learning model that is in alignment with local and state mandates. If we are required to open the school year remotely, we will remain agile in order to return to on-campus learning immediately following county clearance. Our ability to pivot between in-person and remote learning will remain a primary focus as we move toward opening day and beyond.
